

Lesson 1 - Anh Long started the day teaching tones & sounds.

Anh Long explained that the end sounds of words are not so important when speaking Vietnamese. Students received 2 worksheets: [Week 2 - Tone and Sounds](#) .

The class then had a few minutes to write 3 or more of their own sentences using this technique. They then split into smaller groups & practised what they'd written, saying them at least 15 times.
