New Vowel " I "(also Y is the same)

New sound "GI" Pick your sound! Will you speak Northern or Southern?

The sound you choose is up to you, however, try to stick to the one you choose. Perhaps an exception to this is if you choose to speak with the Southern "Y" sound, you may still wish to pronounce Jehovah's name and Jesus' name with the Northern "Z" sound – (this is not by any means a requirement, some consider it to be more respectful)

IÊT – YÊT – IÊC all the same and again only d u s c and d u huy n apply

IT – ICH – the same and again only d u s c and d u huy n apply
